NOTES: Read All Instructions Before Beginning Installation

- Only qualified technicians experienced in the installation and removal of suspension components should perform this installation.
- Use of a hoist and screw jack is highly recommended and will substantially reduce installation time.
- Never work on or under a vehicle unless it is properly supported.

RECOMMENDED FRONT SET-UP

1. Raise the front of the vehicle and support it with the proper safety equipment. **Note: Never work on or under a vehicle that is not supported by the proper safety equipment.**

2. Release the hood latches and remove the front hood as shown. (See Photos 1 & 2)

3. Loosen and remove the upper and lower hardware that secures the coilover, then, remove the coilover from the vehicle as shown. (See Photos 3, 4 & 5)

4. Use a spring compressor to remove the circlip and the spring retainer as shown. (See Photos 6, 7 & 8)

5. You can now remove the main spring, slider and secondary spring as shown. (See Photos 9, 10 & 11)

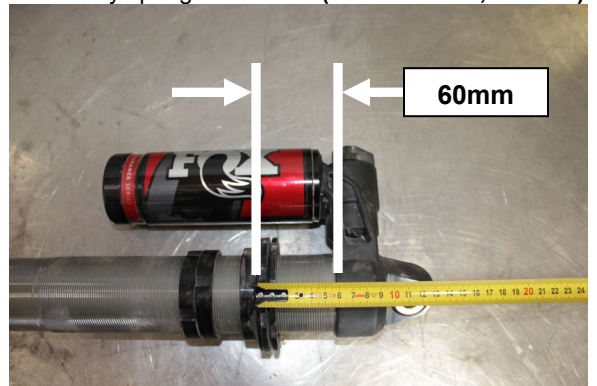

6. Adjust the preload collar and set it at **60mm** as shown. (See Photo 12)

7. Adjust the front crossover rings and set them at **60mm**.

8. You can now install the Eibach secondary spring, provided slider, and main spring as shown. (See Photos 14, 15 & 16)

9. Compress the spring assembly, then, install the spring retainer and circlip as shown. (See Photos 17, 18 & 19)

10. You can now reinstall the coilover using the factory hardware. (See Photos 20, 21 & 22)
11. Repeat the process on the opposite side, then, set the vehicle on the ground, making sure it's fully settled.

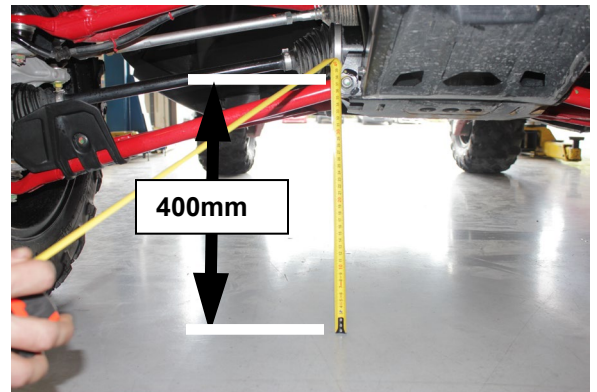

12. You can now adjust the upper preload collar to adjust the ride height. The recommended preload measurement in **Step 6 Photo 12** will get the vehicle close to the recommended ride height but each vehicle may vary some. We recommend setting the ride height at **400mm** measuring from the ground to the center of the lower control arm bolt as shown. (See Photo 23)

RECOMMENDED REAR SET-UP

1. Raise the rear of the vehicle until the wheels are off the ground and the suspension is fully unloaded. **Note:** **Never work on or under a vehicle that is not supported by the proper safety equipment.**

2. Loosen and remove the upper and lower hardware and remove the rear coilover. (See Photos 24, 25 & 26)

13. Use a spring compressor to remove the circlip and the spring retainer/dust shield assembly as shown. (See Photos 27, 28 & 29)

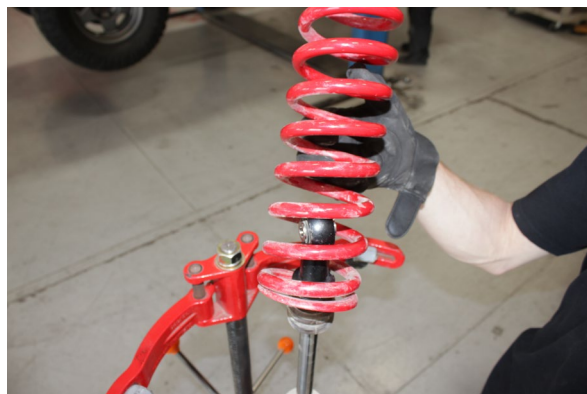

14. You can now remove the main spring, slider and secondary spring as shown. (See Photos 30, 31 & 32)

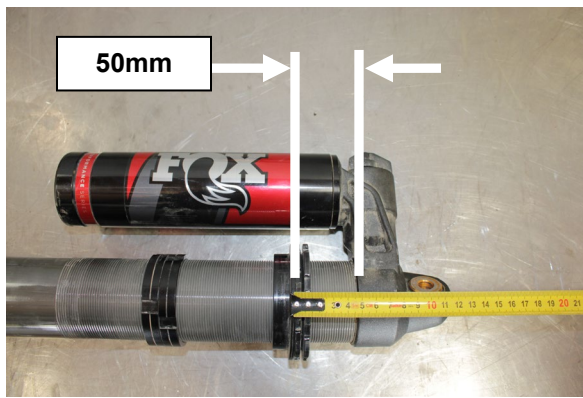

15. Set the preload collars at **50mm** as shown. (See Photo 33)

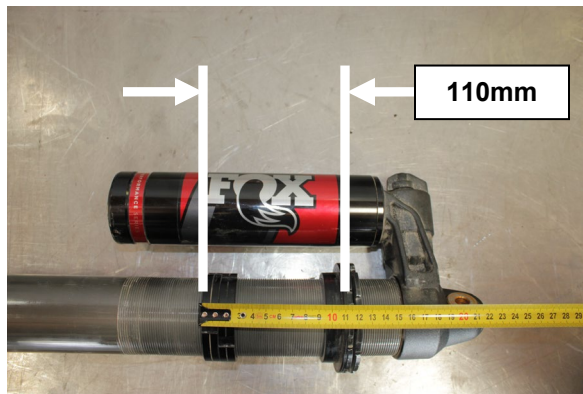

3. Adjust the crossover rings and set them at **110mm** as shown, then, lock them in place. (See Photo 34)

4. You can now install the secondary spring, slider, and main spring as shown. (See Photos 35, 36 & 37)

5. Compress the spring assembly and install the retainer/dust shield assembly and secure it with the circlip as shown. (See Photos 38, 39, 40 & 41)

6. You can now reinstall the coilover and secure it to the upper and lower mounts using the OE hardware as shown. (See Photos 42, 43 & 44)
7. Repeat this procedure on the opposite side.

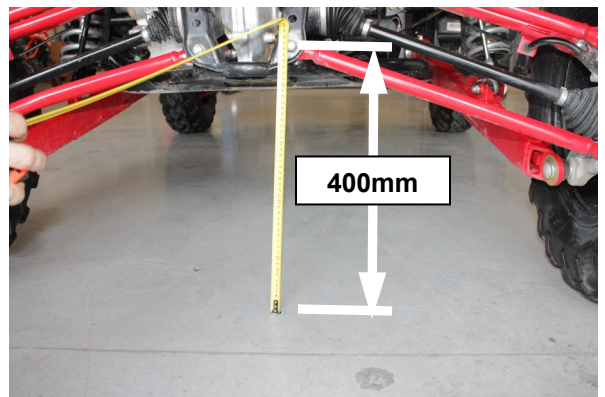

16. You can now adjust the upper preload collar to adjust the ride height. The recommended preload measurement in **Step 15 Photo 33** will get the vehicle close to the recommended ride height but each vehicle may vary some. We recommend setting the ride height at **400mm** measuring from the ground to the center of the lower control arm bolt as shown. (See Photo 45)

All ride height measurements are recorded using the stock 28" tire. Changing tire size will affect the ride height.

RECOMMENDED FRONT AND REAR SHOCK SETTINGS

- Front: #2 Position
- Rear: #2 Position

Note: These are the recommended shock settings that we tested using the spring rates provided in this kit.
