- Use of a hoist and screw jack is highly recommended and will substantially reduce installation time.
- Never work on or under a vehicle unless it is properly supported.

RECOMMENDED FRONT SET-UP

 Raise the front of the vehicle and support it with the proper safety equipment. Note: Never work on or under a vehicle that is not supported by the proper safety equipment.

2. Remove the cover as this will make it easier to access the upper coilover hardware. (See Photo 1)

5. You can now release the spring compressor and remove the main spring, slider and secondary spring as shown. (See Photos 7, 8 & 9)



6. Set the preload collar at **40mm** as shown. (See Photo **10**)



8. You can now install the secondary spring, provided slider, and main spring, then, compress the spring assembly and install the retainer as shown. (See Photos 12, 13, 14, 15 & 16)

- You can now reinstall the coilover using the factory hardware. (See Photos 17, 18 & 19)
- 10. Repeat the process on the opposite side, then, set the vehicle on the ground, making sure it's fully settled.



11. You can now adjust the upper preload collar to adjust the ride height. The recommended preload measurement in Step 6 Photo 10 will get the vehicle close to the recommended ride height but each vehicle may vary some. We recommend setting the ride height at 455mm measuring from the ground to the center of the lower control arm bolt as shown. Note: If you have larger than stock wheels and tires, the ride height will be increased. (See Photo 20)

RECOMMENDED REAR SET-UP

 Raise the rear of the vehicle until the wheels are off the ground and the suspension is fully unloaded. Note: Never work on or under a vehicle that is not supported by the proper safety equipment.







12. Set the preload collar at **60mm** as shown. (See Photo **30**)







- 7. Repeat the process on the opposite side, then, set the vehicle on the ground, making sure it's fully settled.



14. You can now adjust the upper preload collar to adjust the ride height. The recommended preload measurement in Step 12 Photo 30 will get the vehicle close to the recommended ride height but each vehicle may vary some. We recommend setting the ride height at 440mm measuring from the ground to the center of the lower control arm bolt as shown. Note: If you have larger than stock wheels and tires, the ride height will be increased. (See Photo 39)

RECOMMENDED FRONT AND REAR SHOCK SETTINGS

• Front: Set at #2 (3 Position Compression)

• Rear: Set at #2 (3 Position Compression)

Note: These are the recommended shock settings that we tested using the spring rates provided in this kit.
