Instructions

- A. Remove OEM hardware and skids. Retain all fasteners as they will be reused.
- B. Locate the Driver side slider bracket stamped PROR4-L of the Trail Armor skid set. NOTE: The Turbo R 4 and the Pro R 4 share the same slider brackets and sliders. Install is the same on both machines. Install with (2) OEM bolts. See Picture 1. Locate (9) Extruded U-nuts and insert them onto the installed slider bracket. See Picture 2. Locate (1) 1 ¼ TEK Self-drilling screw into the slider bracket. See Picture 3. Repeat this step for the Passenger side. See Picture 4.









C. Locate Panel B of the skid set. Install with (1) OEM bolt and washer. See Picture 5. Next locate Panel C and install with (2) OEM bolts and washers. See Picture 6. Then locate Panel D and install with (2) OEM bolts and washers. See Picture 7.







D. Locate Panel F and install with (2) 1/4 -20 x 1 Serrated Flange bolts and (2) bowl washers. See Picture 8. Repeat step for the Driver side. See Picture 9.





E. Locate Panel A and install with (1) OEM bolt and washer. See Picture 10. Remove previously installed OEM bolts holding the slider brackets in place from Picture 1. Reinstall with a bowl washer. See Picture 11.





F. Locate (8) OEM bolts and washers and install them per Picture 12. Locate (7) 1/2-20x1 Serrated Flange bolts and (7) bowl washers and install per Picture 13. Repeat step for the Driver side. See Picture 14.







- G. Locate (5) M6 x 30mm bolts and (5) bowl washers and install per Picture 15. Repeat step for the Driver side. See Picture 16.
- H. Locate (4) 1 1/4 TEK Self-drilling screws and (4) bowl washers and install per Picture 17.







I. Insert spacer and install (2) M6 x 25mm bolts and (2) bowl washers. See Picture 18 and 18A.







- J. Locate (2) 2" TEK Self-drilling screws and (2) bowl washers and install in Panel D per Picture 19.
- K. Locate (2) 1 1/2" TEK Self-drilling screws and (2) bowl washers and install in Panel D per Picture 20.





L. Locate (3) 1" TEK Self-drilling screws and (3) bowl washers and install in Panel A per Picture 21.
Note: You will need to predrill these (3) holes before installing the 1" TEK screws.
