

PREPERATION _____Lifting



PASSENGER SIDE

Place jack under the **FRONT** center of the **UTV**. Lift until the weight is off the suspension. Ensure that the vehicle is properly secured on jack stands on each side of the frame.

Remove the jack from the center of the frame to access the frame stiffener installment area.

KEEP ALL FACTORY HARDWARE. Loosely fasten hardware until the end of installation when all plates are in place.

FRONT TIRES Removal




Remove front tires. This will help remove weight and ease lower control arm removal at the frame.



Ensure access to frame is clear for installation.

BUMPER Preparation



Remove the (2) **bolts** connecting the bumper to the frame (15mm).



Pull bumper out from frame to gain access to frame bolts. The bumper may need to be fully removed, depending on your model.

Removal **RADIATOR GUARD**



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Remove the radiator guard to gain access to the remaining bumper bolts.



Pull radiator guard out and up, then set aside.

BUMPER





Remove the (2) stock bolts securing the bumper to the frame (15mm).



Ensure there are no wires connected to the bumper. If a magnet is installed, ensure it is released. Pull bumper out to remove.

FRAME TEMPLATE



Removal




Align the provided template to the large hole. Secure with magnet. Create a center punch as a guide for the area to drill.



Use 10mm drill bit to drill holes in frame at the template marks. Repeat on opposite side.

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Remove the lower bolts connecting the control arms to the frame. Remove both front and rear bolts. (18mm)



Repeat on opposite side.

DRILL REAR HOLES

Preparation



Align frame the stiffener to the frame. Secure each side with the M12x1.75x110 bolts with 12mm washers on each side of the bolt followed by a 12mm lock nut.



Mark holes using the rear section of the frame stiffener as a template.



Remove the frame stiffener. Drill (2) 10mm holes on the marked area.




Reinstall the frame stiffener to frame. Loosely secure with (2) M12x1.75x110mm bolts towards the rear followed by 12mm washers on each side then secure both bolts with a 12mm lock nut.

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
FRAME STIFFENER Install

USE THIS FRAME STIFFENER DIAGRAM AS A REFERENCE FOR INSTALL. NOTE: Washers are the same size as the corrisponding bolt EXAMPLE: m12 bolt will have an m12 or 12mm washer.



REAR TABS

Insert the RIGHT rear tab (passenger side) to the rear control arm just behind the collar. This tab should have more space to the outside.




Install

Install left and right rear tabs on end of M12x1.75x30mm bolt.

FRONT TABS Install

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Install **RIGHT front tab (passenger side)** behind the frame. Ensure the hole is offset to the outside of the tab.




Insert the M12x1.75x110mm bolt followed by a 12mm washer.

FRONT TABS Install

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
Loosely secure FRONT TABS to the frame by using a M10x1.5x30mm bolts, a 10mm washer on each side, and a 10mm lock nut.

MIDDLE TABS Install



Slide the middle tab into place. These are not left right specific. Loosely secure the **TOP** of the tab to the **M12x110mm bolt** followed by a **12mm washer** and **12mm lock. nut.**



Loosely secure the **BOTTOM** of the tab with the **M12x35mm bolt** followed by (3) **12mm washers** and a **12mm lock. nut.**



TORQUE HARDWARE IN THIS SEQUENCE: Torque all bolts to 45 ftlb.

- 1) Front collar bolts (control arm bolts)
- 2) Rear collar bolts (control arm bolts)
- 3) Rear tab bolts
- 4) Middle tab bolts
- 5) Front frame bolts.

Reinstall bumper, wires, and magnet (if applicable). Reinstall tires.
